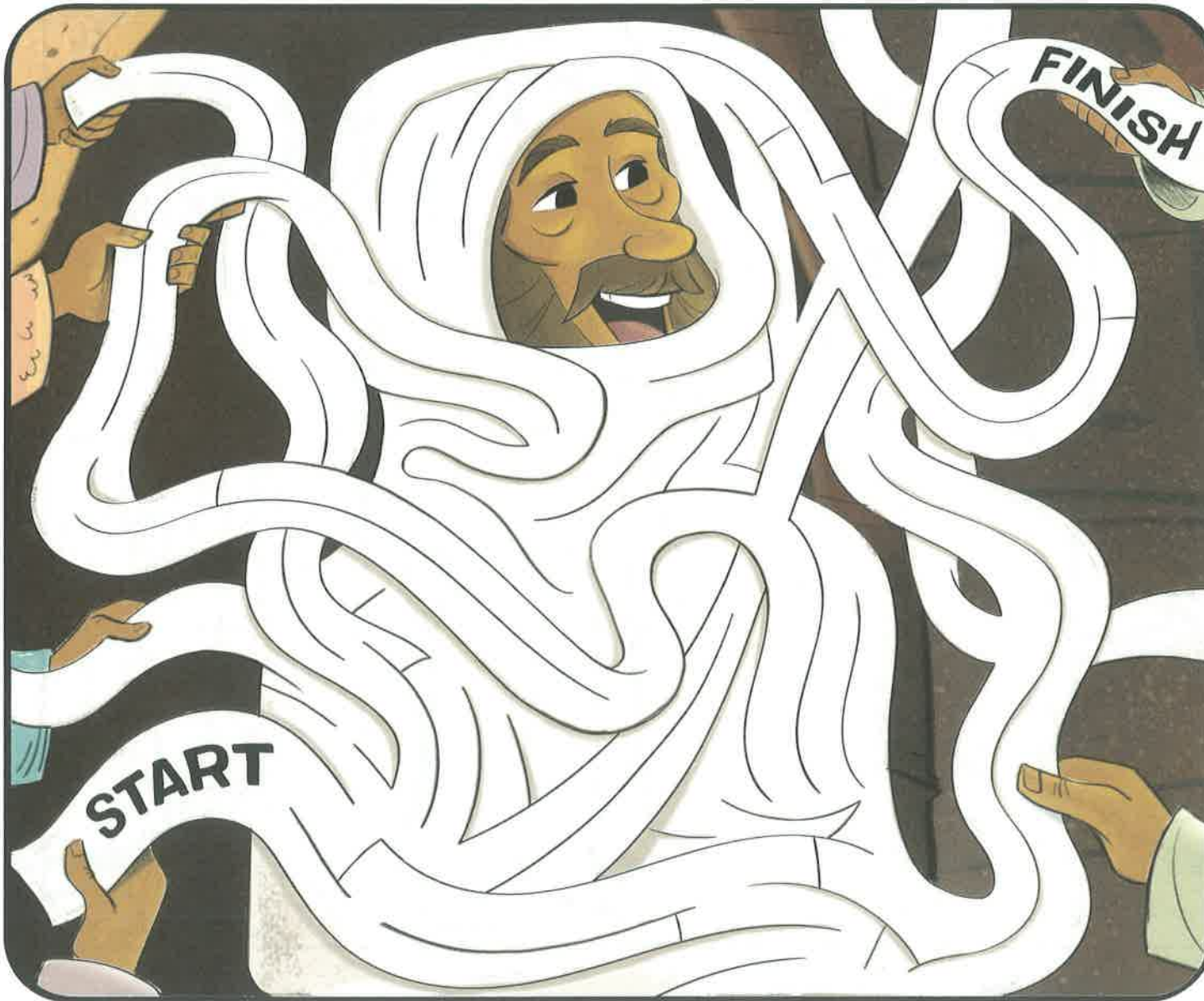


Unwrap Laz

Unit 25 • Session 4 Jesus Raised Lazarus

BIBLE STORY SUMMARY:

- Mary and Martha sent word to Jesus that their brother was sick.
- Jesus traveled to Bethany, but He arrived after Lazarus had been dead four days.
- Jesus commanded Lazarus to come out of the grave, and Lazarus did!
- Jesus has power over death.

KEY PASSAGE: Colossians 1:13-14

BIG PICTURE QUESTION:

- How does God care for His creation? God loves and rules over His creation according to His perfect plan.

FAMILY DISCUSSION STARTERS:

- What does it mean for Jesus to be “the resurrection and the life”?
- How can Christians feel joy even in the middle of sad times?
- What is eternal life, and when does it begin?

FAMILY ACTIVITY:

- Work with your family to prepare and deliver a care package to someone in your church who has experienced a recent loss. Pray that the Lord will provide comfort and peace. Discuss the hope Jesus gives.

Jesus Raised Lazarus

John 11

STORY POINT: JESUS HAS POWER OVER DEATH.

Jesus and Lazarus were friends. One day, Lazarus got sick. Mary and Martha sent a message to Jesus. "Lord, Your friend Lazarus is sick," they said. Jesus stayed where He was for two more days. Then Jesus said, "Let's go back to Judea." By the time Jesus arrived in Bethany, Lazarus had been in a tomb for four days. Martha said, "Lord, if You had been here, my brother wouldn't have died."

Jesus said, "I am the resurrection and the life. The one who believes in Me, even if he dies, will live. Do you believe this?"

"Yes, Lord," Martha said. "I believe You are the Messiah, the Son of God."

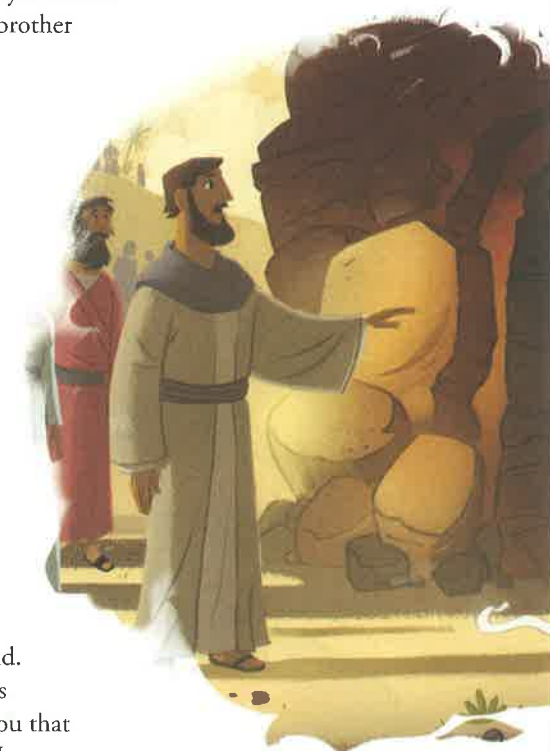
Martha went back to her house. She told Mary that Jesus wanted to see her. Mary fell at Jesus' feet and said, "Lord, if You had been here, my brother would not have died!" Mary was crying. Jesus wept too.

Mary led Jesus to the tomb where Lazarus was buried. It was a cave, and a huge stone covered the opening. "Remove the stone," Jesus said.

So the stone was moved aside. Jesus looked up and said, "Father, I thank You that You heard Me." Then Jesus shouted, "Lazarus, come out!"

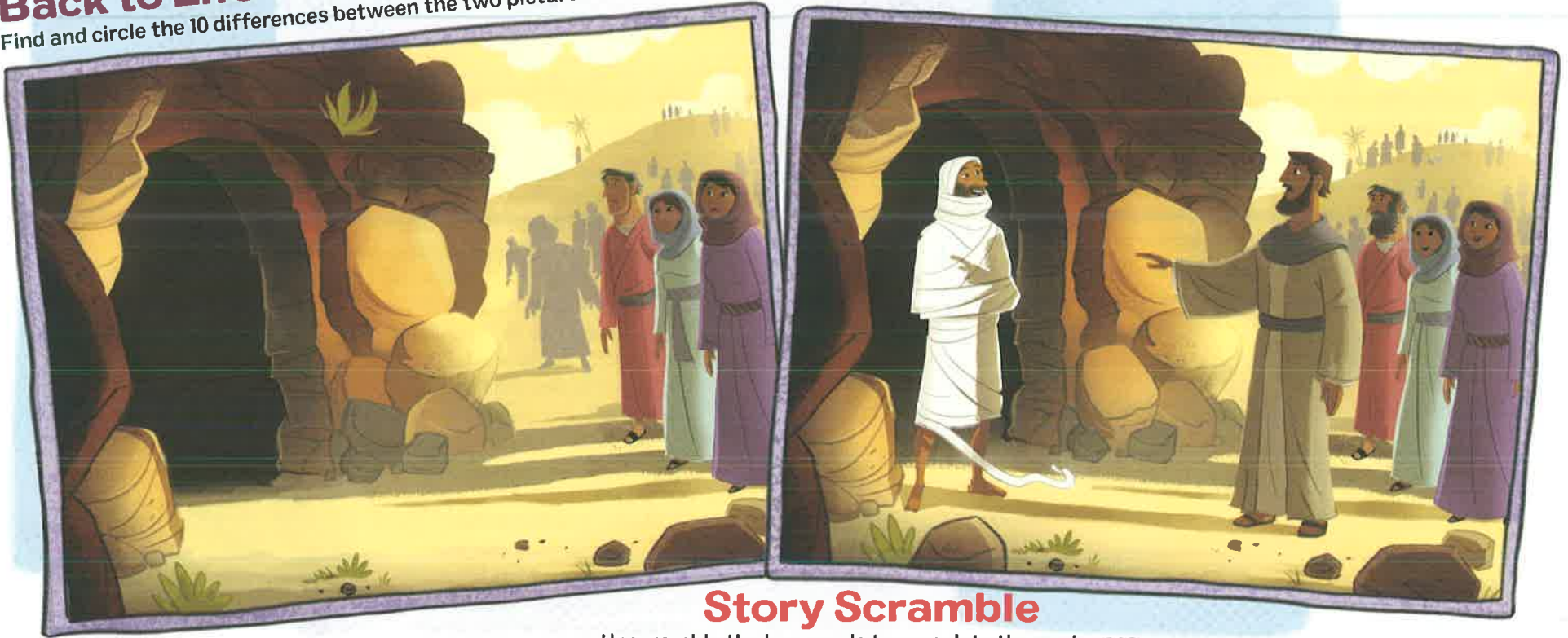
Lazarus came out of the tomb, wrapped in linen and cloth. Jesus said, "Unwrap him and let him go."

Christ Connection: When Jesus raised Lazarus from the dead, He showed that He has power over death. Jesus said, "I am the resurrection and the life." Jesus died on the cross for our sins and rose from the dead. He gives eternal life to those who trust in Him.
