

Unit 26 · Session 1 Jesus' Triumphal Entry

BIBLE STORY SUMMARY:

- Jesus traveled to Jerusalem.
- He sent Peter and John to find a donkey for Him to ride into the city as prophecy said.
- People welcomed Jesus to Jerusalem as their King.
- The religious leaders were angry that people praised Him.

KEY PASSAGE: Philippians 2:8

BIG PICTURE QUESTION:

• What did Jesus do to save us? Jesus lived a sinless life, died on the cross, and rose from the dead.

FAMILY DISCUSSION STARTERS:

- How is Jesus our perfect King?
- What does is mean to worship Jesus as King?
- What are ways we can show Jesus is our King?

FAMILY ACTIVITY:

- Play a game like "King of the Hill" with your kids. Talk to them about Jesus' kingdom and how we can become part of it.
- Organize a mock parade on your street. Invite neighbors to participate. Discuss the ways Jesus' triumphal entry was like a parade.

Jesus' Triumphal Entry

Matthew 21; Mark 11; Luke 19; John 12

STORY POINT: PEOPLE WELCOMED JESUS TO JERUSALEM AS THEIR KING.

Jesus and His disciples traveled to Jerusalem. Jesus sent two of His disciples ahead into a village. "As soon as you enter the village," Jesus told them, "you will find a young donkey tied there. No one has ever sat on it. Untie it and bring it here. If anyone says to you 'Why are you doing this?' say, 'The Lord needs it."


The disciples did as Jesus asked. They brought the donkey to Jesus, threw their robes onto the donkey, and helped Jesus get onto it. People spread their robes along the road for Jesus, and others spread palm branches cut from the fields.

The whole crowd praised God. "Hosanna!" they said. "Blessed is He who comes in the name of the Lord! Hosanna in the highest heaven!"

Some religious leaders asked Jesus to tell His disciples to be quiet. Jesus answered, "If they did not praise Me, the rocks would praise Me!"

While Jesus was in the temple complex, people who were blind and people who were lame came to Him. Jesus healed them.

Jesus went to the town of Bethany to spend the night.
